

Decision Making Process

Role of Councilors

- Mayor / Head of Council does not take individual action
- Members' commitment is to their constituents
- Transparency – legislation/negotiations not perfected behind closed doors prior to tabling
- The recommendation of the concerned committee is thoroughly discussed in the house before concluding on the decision

Legislative Process

The Municipal council is constituted by the ward members/ councilors who are elected members and accountable to the public of their respective municipal wards. The process of decision making by municipal council is as per the following



Role of Administration

The administration is governed by Jharkhand Municipal Act 2011 and subsequent amendments. Its role is to implement

- Council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carryout Council's decisions

- Undertake research and provide advice to Council on the policies and programs of the Municipality
- Carryout other duties required under this or any Act or other duties assigned
- The administration head i.e. Municipal commissioner is held accountable by Jharkhand Municipal Act2011 and employees in general by Executive Rules of Business as prescribed for functioning of different departments
